

IOM SUDAN HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE MONTHLY UPDATE August 2017

In August 2017, IOM reached over **161,000** beneficiaries with humanitarian field activities through: **21** Displacement Tracking Matrix (DTM) activities (17 registration missions and 4 tracking activities); **7** Emergency Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) activities; health and nutrition assistance via **4** nutrition clinics in West Darfur, **3** primary health care facilities in North Darfur, and **1** primary health care facility in South and East Darfur each, **1** health campaign and several trainings as part of Acute Water Diarrhea response; **8** Emergency Shelter/Non-Food Items assessment, distribution and post distribution missions.

EMERGENCY WASH

- **2** hand pumps, serving water to **600** beneficiaries, were rehabilitated in Bela El Serif village, East Jabel Marra locality, South Darfur.
- **49,100** individuals were supported via provision of chlorine, to treat water by chlorination, in Bela El Serif village, East Jabel Marra locality, South Darfur.
- **3** hand pumps were rehabilitated to support **1,000** beneficiaries in El Lirri locality, South Kordofan.
- **2** Ventilated Improved Pit (VIP) latrines were constructed providing proper sanitation solution for an estimated **320** persons per day in El Nimer Camp, Assalaya locality, East Darfur.
- **9** VIP latrines were constructed in El Fardous reception center, East Darfur, providing proper sanitation solution for an estimated **1,450** persons per day.
- Baseline survey (ECHO project) was conducted covering **624** households and **26** water facilities in Tawilla locality, North Darfur.
- WASH Study activities were conducted including training for **40** surveyors, followed by **4,000** household surveys, mapping of **53** water sources, and 1 focus group discussion in Abu Shouk camp, North Darfur.

DTM

- DTM teams completed **17** registration missions, consisting of **3** missions in North Darfur, **1** in South Darfur, **2** in Central Darfur, **5** in West Kordofan and **6** in South Kordofan.
- **50,351** returnees were registered at several locations in Central Darfur, South Kordofan and North Darfur States. This included **8,532** returnees registered in Rashad and Dalami localities of South Kordofan, and **41,819** individuals registered in Rokero, Central Darfur, most of whom had returned in 2016.
- A total of **6,028** IDPs were registered, including **5,106** IDPs registered in Rokero, Central Darfur, **690** in Dalami, South Kordofan, and **232** in Tawilla, North Darfur. Most of the registered IDPs were displaced in 2016 from the Jabel Marra areas.
- DTM teams also registered **20,690** refugees from South Sudan in South Kordofan (**1,529** refugees) and West Kordofan (**19,161** refugees at **140** sites).

Rapid Response Fund



- **31,138** direct and indirect beneficiaries were supported by Rapid Response Fund via emergency WASH and ES/NFI assistance in South Kordofan and Central Darfur respectively.
- Mercy Corps – Scotland continued support to **17,683** newly displaced IDPs and affected host community members via provision of WASH assistance in Abu Kershola, and Kadugli localities, South Kordofan.
- Triangle Generation Humanitaire supported **13,455** beneficiaries in Um Dukhun locality, Central Darfur with ES/NFI support.

ES/NFI

Individuals were directly supported by ES/NFI assistance

- **6** ES/NFI distribution and **2** post distribution monitoring (PDM) missions were conducted.
- **118** ES/NFI kits were distributed for newly displaced IDPs and for families affected by floods in Dar El Salam and Kabkabiya localities, North Darfur.
- **11** Plastic sheets were distributed for vulnerable population in Ardamata and Krinding IDP Camps in West Darfur.
- **10** Plastic sheets were distributed to support El Ferdous Clinic in East Darfur.
- **800** Mosquito Nets and **3,550** bars of soap were distributed to **400** vulnerable households (**200** IDP HHs and **200** Returnee HHs) in Dalami Locality, South Kordofan.
- **2** Post Distribution Monitoring (PDM) missions were conducted at Korma IDP gathering site, North Darfur and El Serif IDP Camp, South Darfur.

EMERGENCY HEALTH AND NUTRITION

- IOM in coordination with SMOH and partners continued supporting **4** nutrition clinics in West Darfur, **3** primary health care facilities in North Darfur, and **1** primary health care facility in South and East Darfur each, offering the Minimum Basic Health Package (MBHP). These clinics provided lifesaving health and nutrition assistance, including medical consultations and health promotion activities, to over **9,000** beneficiaries.
- Environmental hygiene, garbage collection and hygiene promotion campaigns are currently ongoing in Kabkabiya Town, North Darfur.

Acute Water Diarrhea (AWD) Response:

- **30** health workers were trained on surveillance and appropriate management of AWD in West Darfur. The trained staff is currently working in **15** facilities, in Forbaranga, El Geneina, Habila, Mornei and Um Tajook, which routinely provide nutrition and medical assistance to a catchment area targeting **30,000** people.
- Similarly, in El Fasher, Kebakabiya, Tabit El Serif and Tawilla **31** staff working in the Isolation Ward for inpatient management of AWD were trained on infection prevention and control.
