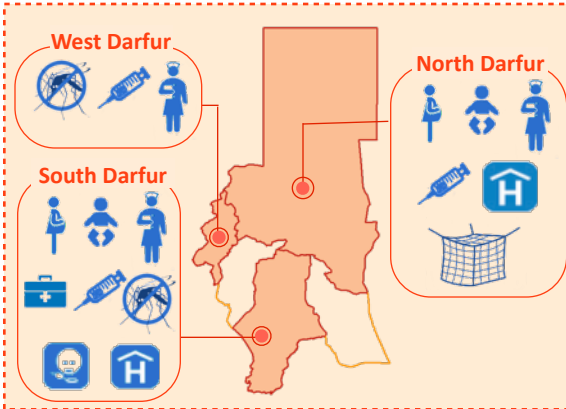

## TRAININGS AND AWARENESS PROGRAMS



• IOM's various Nutrition, General and Public Health trainings and awareness programs had the following impact:

**Community Health Workers (CHWs) trained** on general health matters like safe drinking water, good practices in personal hygiene, food handling, awareness of water borne diseases, correct water storage practices, importance of immunization.

**Community Health Workers (CHWs) trained on Nutrition:** to do Middle Upper Arm Circumference (MUAC) screenings, Weight-for-Height method, and Z-scores assessments, and on Community Based Management of Malnutrition (CMAM), good feeding practices etc.
