# Rapid Response Fund Annual Factsheet (January – December 2016)

The Sudan Rapid Response Fund (RRF), USAID/OFDA's unique funding mechanism, is designed to respond very quickly to the critical needs of newly displaced IDPs and returnees in Sudan. Managed by the IOM since 2013, the RRF has provided life-saving health, protection, ES/NFI and WASH assistance to 523,000 beneficiaries in 2016.

# WASH



- 1- Emergency critical life-saving Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) response to newly displaced populations from Jebel Marra to Tawilla IDP camp in North Darfur.**
  - 2- New returnees in Moradaf, Garaia and Beltebei, Um Dukhun locality, Central Darfur State.**
- Output 1:** IDPs and returnees have access to sufficient, safe water.
  - Output 2:** IDPs and returnees have access to hygienic sanitation facilities.
  - Output 3:** Environmental cleaning campaigns reach new IDPs, returnees and host communities.
  - Output 4:** IDPs and returnees receive hygiene items.

# Protection



- ## Provision of Urgent & Critical Protection Services in Kutum (North Darfur).
- Output 1:** Shared and documented information management system reports on critical needs of 9,600 IDPs.
  - Output 2:** Strengthened two traditional social support structures.
  - Output 3:** Directly assisted 2,542 vulnerable IDPs.
  - Output 4:** Supported 1,000 vulnerable IDPs through mapped referrals.

# ES/NFI



- 1- Improved Emergency Shelters (ES) and Non Food Items (NFI) Emergency Response for at-risk, conflict-affected, newly displaced persons in Garaia and Beltebei, Um Dukhun Locality, Central Darfur State.**
  - 2- NFI support to address the immediate needs of the flood affected population in Alnihood locality, West Kordofan State.**
- Output 1:** 1,000 newly displaced, conflict-affected households receive Improved Emergency Shelters for protection from the elements to mitigate health threats.
  - Output 2:** 1,241 newly displaced, conflict-affected households receive Non-Food Items.
