



Rapid Response Fund Fact Sheet (January – June 2016)

The Rapid Response Fund (RRF), USAID/OFDA's unique funding mechanism, is designed to respond very quickly to the critical needs of newly displaced IDPs and returnees in Sudan. Managed by the IOM since 2013, this year alone, the RRF has provided life-saving, WASH, Health, Emergency Shelter / Non Food Item and Protection assistance to over 500,000 beneficiaries.

Health

World Relief Comprehensive Response to Dengue Outbreak in Kerenik Locality in West Darfur

- Outcome1:** Strengthened surveillance systems for dengue and malaria.
- Outcome2:** Improved case management of VHF and Malaria.
- Outcome3:** Strengthened community level prevention through improving awareness about the breakouts.

WASH 2 projects- North & Central Darfur

Life-saving WASH response to newly displaced populations from Jabel Mara to Tawilla IDPs camp in North Darfur/Emergency WASH response for new returnees in Um Dukhun locality, Central Darfur

- Outcome1:** New IDPs/returnees have access to safe and sufficient water supply.
- Outcome 2:** New IDPs/returnees have access to hygienic sanitation facilities.
- Outcome3:** New IDPs/returnees have improved hygiene knowledge and practices through promotion campaigns and provision of hygiene items.

Protection

Provision of Urgent & Critical Protection Services in Kutum (North Darfur)

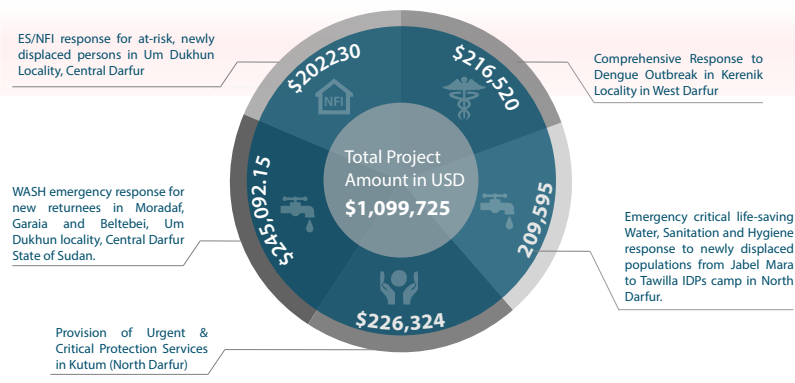
- Outcome1:** Develop information management systems and share reports on the humanitarian condition of new IDPs.
- Outcome2:** Enhanced humanitarian protection monitoring and reporting of most vulnerable IDPs.
- Outcome3:** Vulnerable IDPs are supported through referrals and other services.

Emergency Shelter / Non Food Item

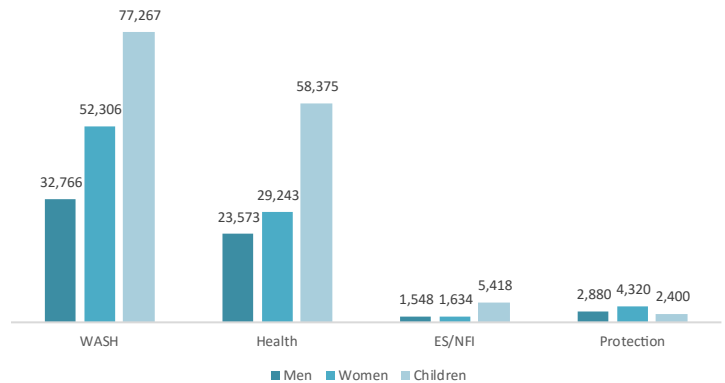
ES/NFI response for at-risk, newly displaced persons in Um Dukhun Locality, Central Darfur

Outcome: Health threats are mitigated in newly displaced households through receipt of Improved Emergency Shelters and Non-Food Items that protect them from the elements.

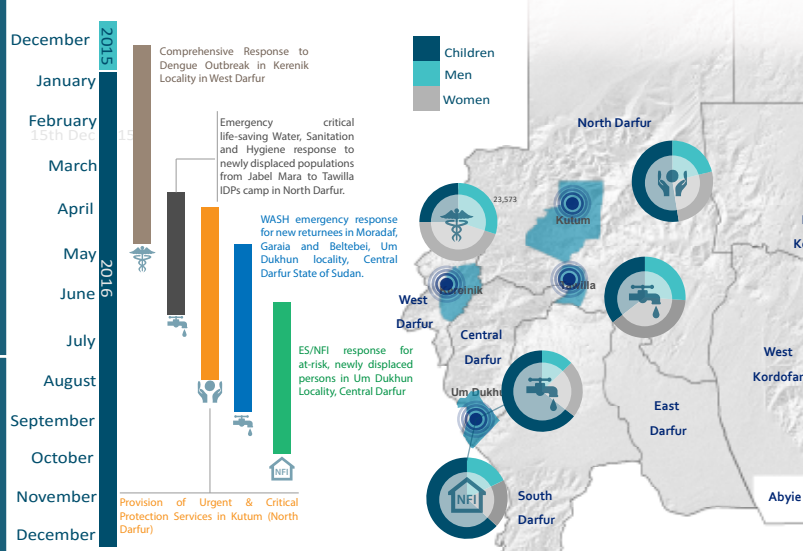
Total Project Amount in USD
