

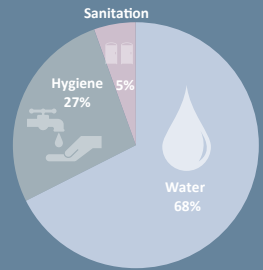

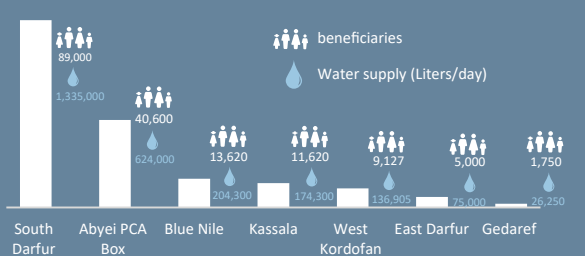

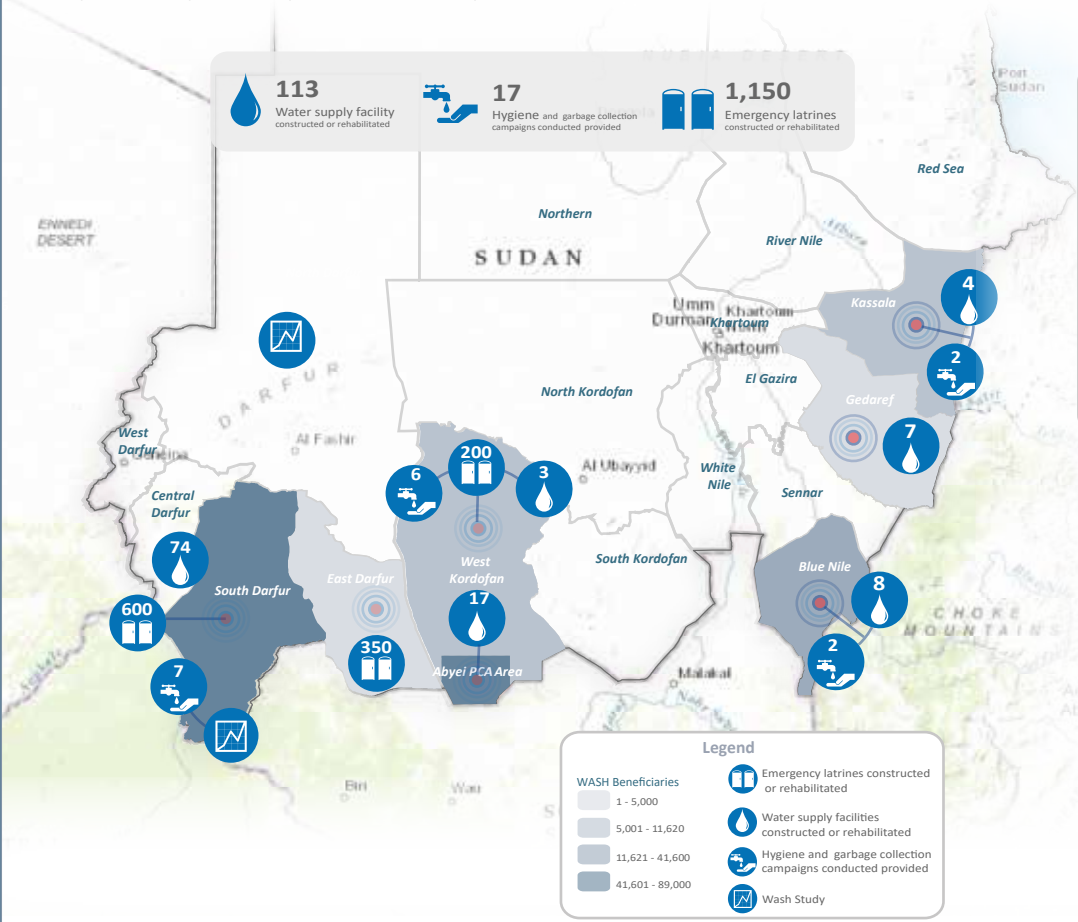

IOM Sudan has responded to both protracted and sudden on-set emergencies through the provision of life-saving WASH interventions. Humanitarian and emergency assistance was tailored to target specific needs in East Darfur, South Darfur, West Kordofan, Kassala, Gedaref and Blue Nile states. IOM's WASH support also extends to development programmes aimed at increasing livelihood opportunities, and mitigating conflict by improving access to basic services in Abyei, Blue Nile, Gedaref, Kassala, Red Sea states, and all Darfur states.

Water purification kits distributed in response to floods and the Acute Watery Diarrhea (AWD) emergency.

AWD Emergency response is currently on-going in North Darfur, South Darfur, East Darfur and West Darfur states.

Early Recovery Initiatives

IOM in South Darfur, in coordination with Water Environmental Sanitation (WES), has set up and registered with the Ministry of Welfare "The Water and Agriculture Charity Association for Otash".
