RETURN & REINTEGRATION ASSISTANCE Fact Sheet

Migrants returning from neighboring Egypt, Libya and KSA as well as from European countries, whether voluntary or deported, will continue to be in need of reintegration assistance. This is more so as they are a caseload not usually targeted by ongoing UN humanitarian livelihood programmes.

IOM Sudan's reintegration package consists of (i) Post arrival counseling and reorientation (ii) vocational and business development trainings for heads of returnee families and (iii) referral for community infrastructure development projects which benefit returnees as well as the host communities (e.g. water and sanitation projects).

From 2005 to 2014 IOM has assisted 1062 migrants returning to Sudan with the return and reintegration assistance. Some returning migrants received the reintegration package in the form of cash or in kind reintegration contribution. The in kind reintegration assistance involves counseling to set up a small business activity or educational activity and follow-up monitoring.

IOM Sudan Reintegration usually consists of below step or some parts of the below steps :

1. Assessment prior return
2. Counseling for Individual Case
3. Guidance and Consultation on Reintegration Assistance Option e.g. Business Set Up/ Self employment, Educations/Vocational Training, Job Placement and medical treatment/financial support.
4. Payment of Reintegration Grant (in kind or in cash)
5. Monitoring on Reintegration Assistance (3 month, 6 month and one year after return)

The amount of reintegration grant per case or per individual differs from one country to another countries. It varies from around 600 USD/485 Euro to around 3000 USD / 20.000 NOR depending to the exchange rate of each month.

In the coming years IOM will continue supporting a variety of measures that contribute towards reintegration primarily focusing on income generation opportunities, especially for the younger generation of returnees in order to assist them in avoiding to engage in illicit or illegal activities or in needing to re-migrate.
