

23,300 Mats / Mattresses Through IOM Sudan's shelters and Non-Food items projects, 64,616 beneficiaries including: Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs). Returnees, Refugees and population affected by man-made or natural disasters in North, South, Central and West Darfur states as well as South Kordofan State received Emergency Shelters, Transitional Shelters and Non-Food Items. 66% of the assisted population were IDPs, 24% Returnees and 10% were Refugees and other affected populations. In addition to the emergency and life-saving interventions, IOM provided Returnees with more durable transitional shelters to sustain their return. IOM Sudan's Shelters and Non-Food Items projects were implemented in close coordination with the ES/NFI sector lead UNHCR and the Humanitarian Aid Commission (HAC).
