

Emergency Shelters / Non Food Items

IOM Sudan provided Emergency Shelters / Non Food Items (ES/NFI) and Improved Emergency Shelters (IES) to newly Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs), vulnerable crisis affected populations, and returnee communities across North Darfur, South Darfur and West Darfur. ES/NFI assistance continues to provide the most vulnerable mobile populations with life-saving protection from elements, as well as a minimum level of dignity and privacy.

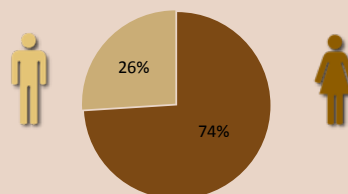

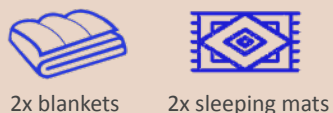
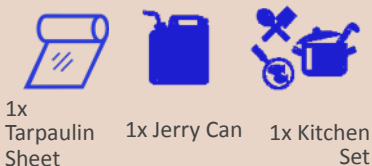

Shelters Provided : **1,193**

IES provides a longer term solution. Composed of locally sourced environment friendly materials, IES provides a one room four walled structure which is easily assembled and is robustly supported by wooden poles.



ES/NFI assistance is dependent on the assessment and registration of affected populations through the Displacement Tracking Matrix. Partners include the ES/NFI sector lead, HAC, national and international NGO partners.
