



IOM SUDAN RESETTLEMENT OPERATIONS OVERVIEW 2016

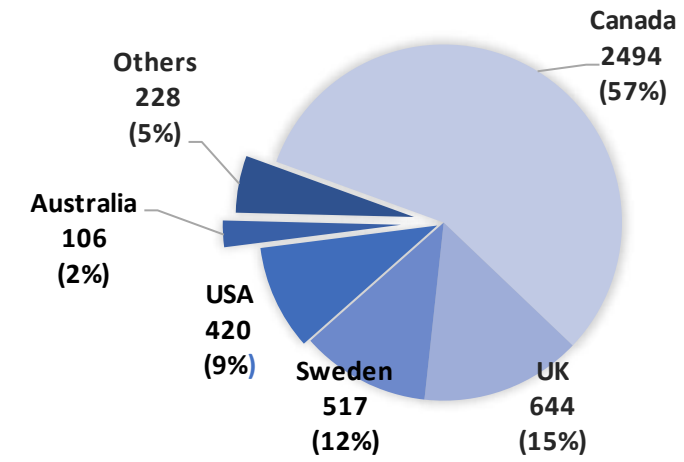


From January to December 2016, IOM Assisted 4,409 refugees to resettle in 14 countries. Top 5 major destinations were Canada (absorbed 57% of the refugees), UK, Sweden, US and Australia, that together account for 94.8% of the resettled caseload. The remainder 9 countries represent 5% of the total resettlement admissions. In 2016, the volume of IOM Sudan's resettlement operations was 130% higher than what it used to be five years back, namely in 2012.

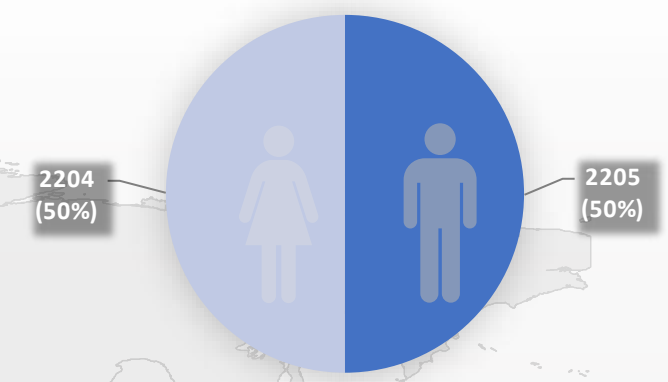
IOM's resettlement activities comprise:

- (1) making arrangements for applicants' interviews.
- (2) conducting medical screening and health assessments to identify applicants' health needs and allow for treatment and follow up in countries of resettlement
- (3) preparing travel arrangements including land transportation and flight bookings
- (4) processing exit permits from their place of residence to Khartoum airport and on to final destinations.
- (5) refugees accepted for re-settlement receive cultural orientation and, where possible, some basic language training to prepare themselves to adjust and to facilitate the initial stages of their assimilation in the respective country of resettlement.
- (6) conducting pre-departure medical screening to ensure that refugees moving under the auspices of IOM are fit to travel and that they receive appropriate medical attention and assistance during all phases of their travel to the country of resettlement.

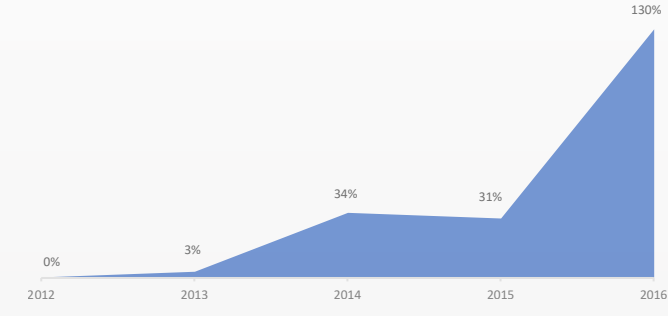
Top countries of resettlement of refugees from Sudan in 2016



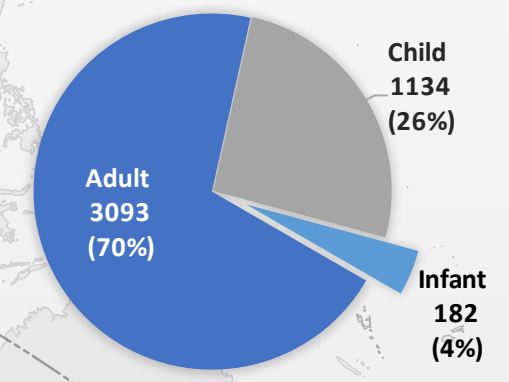
Overall Gender Breakdown of refugees assisted to resettle from Sudan in 2016



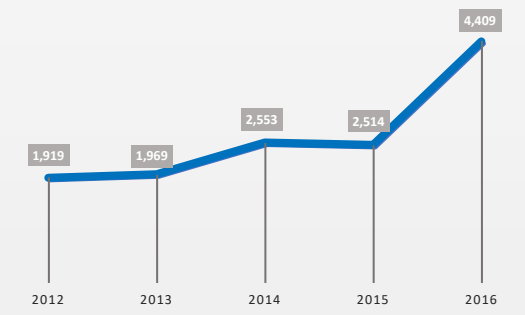
Progress of resettlement movements from Sudan (2012-2016)
